Holy Spirit	God's power that helps and guides people.		
Inspiration	God helping someone to say or do something.		
Pentecost	When the Holy Spirit came to Jesus' followers.		
Trinity	One God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

What do Christians believe about the nature and character of the Holy Spirit?
