What does it mean to be called by God?

God	Christians believe God made and loves everyone.		The Old Testament Prophets were called by God to give his message to the people. The Prophets were telling the people to turn back to God and mend their relationship with him. This is the beginning of God's salvation plan.
Ministry	The work someone does to help and teach others about God.		
Old Testament	The first part of the Bible, written before Jesus was born.		
Ordination	A special service when someone becomes a church leader.		
Prophet	A person who hears messages from God and shares them.		
Key Questions: What does it mean to be called by God? In what ways does God call people? How does God speak to people? What sort of tasks does God call people to do? Who has been/or could be called by God? What is the role of a faith leader who has been called by God? What are the similarities and differences between the role and daily lives of faith leaders?		Writing/Provision/Enrichment opportunities	People are called by God today, and their lives are changed as they respond in a variety of ways e.g. ordination, ministry in the local church or missionary work abroad etc.
