Why do Christians believe Jesus is the Son of God?

Subject specific Vocabulary		Images/Diagrams/Maps	Important Knowledge
Authority	The power or right to give orders, make decisions, or tell others what to do.		Christians believe Jesus is the Son of God; he was both God and man. Christians believe Jesus has power and authority from God over every aspect of creation, life and death. There are people who have stood up and spoken out against authorities in situations of injustice. The Jewish holy day is Shabbat and there are many traditions and rules associated with Shabbat.
Miracle	An amazing event that can't be explained by natural laws, often believed to be done by God, like healing the sick.		
Pharisees	A group of Jewish religious leaders who followed the law very strictly and often disagreed with Jesus.		
Sabbath/ Shabbat	A holy day of rest and worship. For Jews, it is from Friday evening to Saturday evening, while for Christians, it is on Sunday.		
Son of God	A title for Jesus, meaning Christians believe He is God's Son, sent to help and save the world.		
Key Questions How do we know Jesus had power and authority? Where did Jesus' power and authority come from? How do the actions of Jesus show that he is the Son of God? How do the actions of Jesus show his divine nature? How do these stories reveal Jesus to be the Son of God? What do Christians believe about Jesus and God because of these events?
