### **KS2 Outcomes:**

There were 10 children in our Year 6 class eligible for Pupil Premium in 2018-2019.

Attainment

60% of our Pupil Premium eligible children met or exceeded the expected standard in Reading.

70% of our Pupil Premium eligible children met or exceeded the expected standard in Writing

60% of our Pupil Premium eligible children met or exceeded the expected standard in Maths.

80% of our Pupil Premium eligible children met or exceeded the expected standard in SPAG.

30% of our Pupil Premium eligible children met or exceeded the expected standard in RWM.

### **KS1 Outcomes:**

There were 13 children in our Year 2 class eligible for Pupil Premium in 2018-2019.

61.5% of our Pupil Premium eligible children (including SEN) met or exceeded the expected standard in Reading.

61.5% of our Pupil Premium eligible children (including SEN) met or exceeded the expected standard in Writing.

69% of our Pupil Premium eligible children (including SEN) met or exceeded the expected standard in Maths.

### **Year 1 Phonics Outcomes:**

There were 6 children in our Year 1 class eligible for Pupil Premium in 2018-2019.

50% of our Pupil Premium eligible children (including SEN) met or exceeded the expected standard in Phonics.

### **Foundation Stage Good Level of Development**

There were 7 children in our Reception class eligible for Pupil Premium in 2018-2019.

43 % of our Pupil Premium eligible children met or exceeded the expected standard at the end of Foundation stage.
